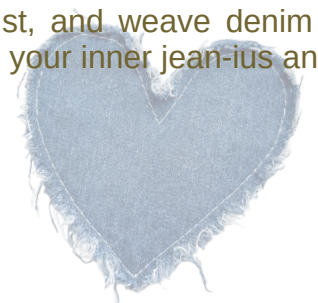

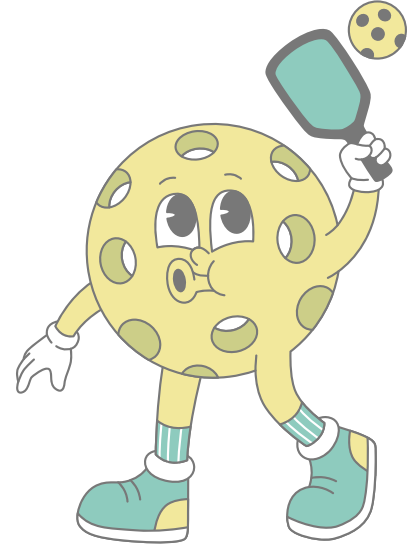
Adult Pickleball League

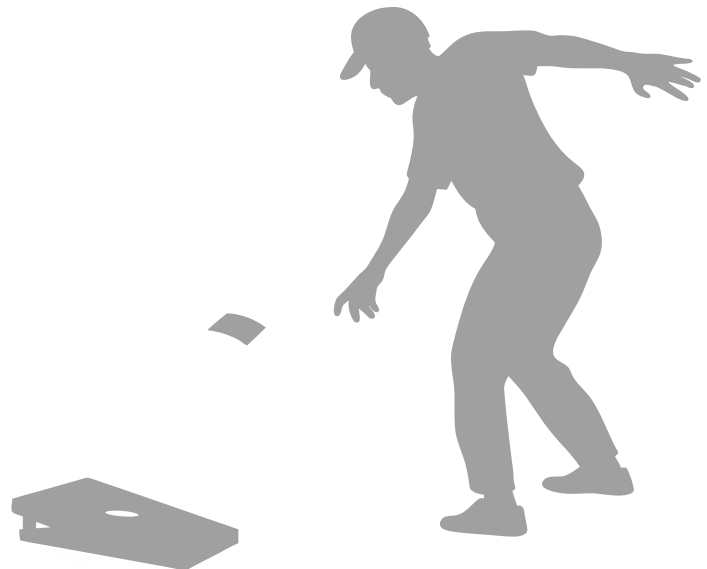
Adult Bags/Cornhole League

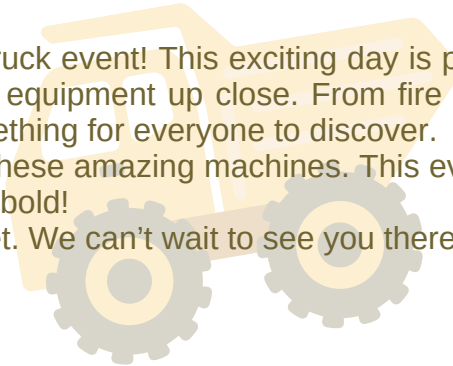

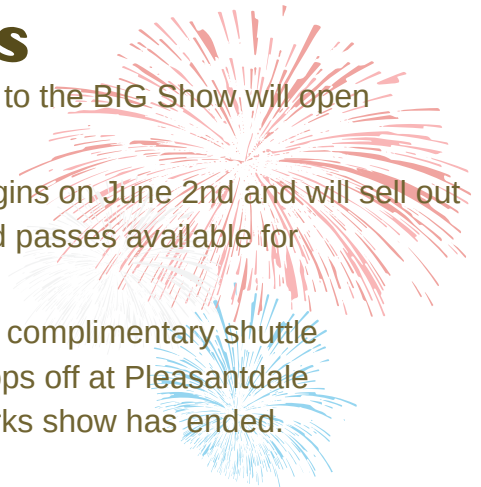
3rd of July Annual Fireworks

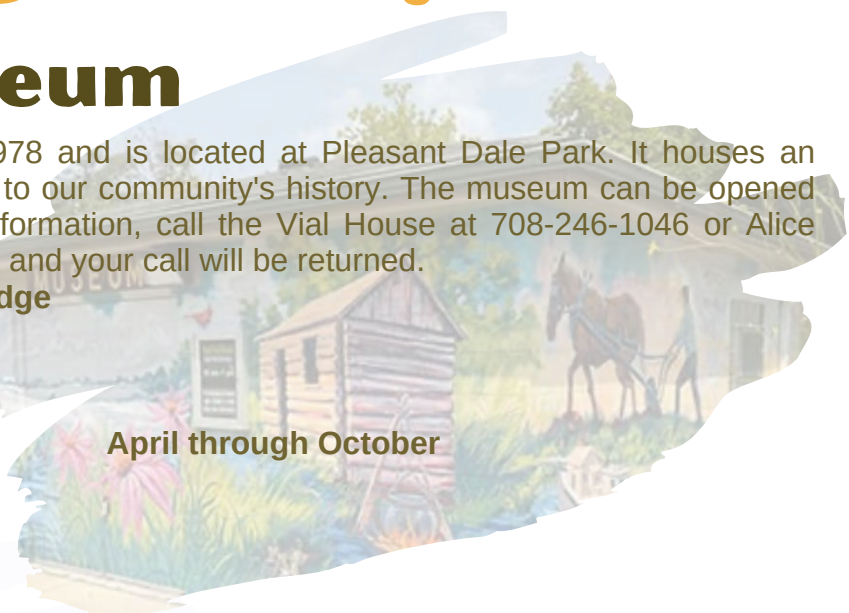

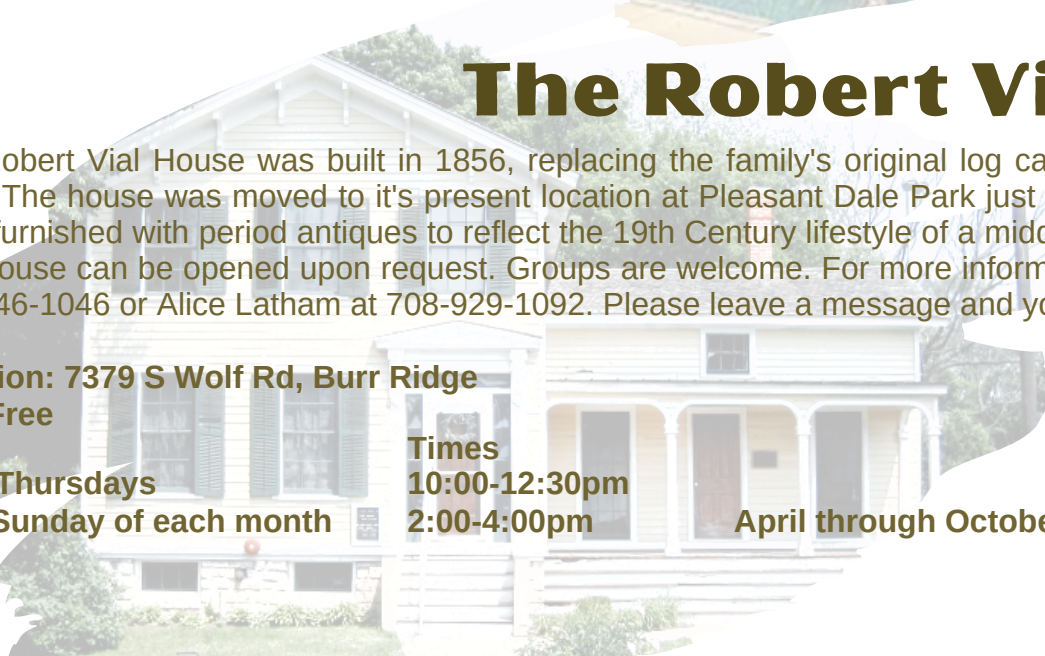

Learn about the small unincorporated town called Tiedtville, which started out as a tavern, dance pavilion, and horse track, and expanded into a town with a grocery store, a post office, a butcher shop, a bowling alley, a barbershop, and its own jail! Summer cottages were also available so you could escape the big city.

In 1953, the town was torn down and turned into a very popular auto and motorcycle racetrack. Many photos of the town, racetrack, drivers, and events will be on display.
